- A. Update Opal Hellweg, 3rd District Legislative Assistant
 - · Opan reported that there are no new Solar Permits in our WMAC area (tho some just outside area).
 - Cathy Bechtel should be able to attend June 14th WMAC.
 - Cindy Domenigoni went to a workshop at EMWD to explore whether EMWD would be willing to pay for the 'Winchester' sign on the recycled water tank on the hill; answer: Negative.
 - Opal noted that the new office of Sup. Stone is on State Street in Hemet, near the Courthouse.
 - Emery Papp: Works for the City of Hemet. MWD held an open work study session with City Council; nothing was finalized. One scheme involves solar energy. Papp stated that he hopes to attend our WMAC meetings; to act as a liaison of sorts.
