- Various areas: Homeland MDP (Master Drainage Plan). Winchester Hills. Green Acres and Winchester Drainage Plan areas. Green Acres Dam.

- · Padres shared the Five-Year C/P Development Process.
- · Questions/comments from the public included:
- · C: There is an open manhole (no cover). A: OK; will look into that.
- · Q: Highland Palms has a low wash area with standing water. A: Privately owned; contact the HOA.
- · Q: What kind of funding does Zone 4 get? A: About \$4 out of every \$1,000. Annual revenues \$20-25M.
